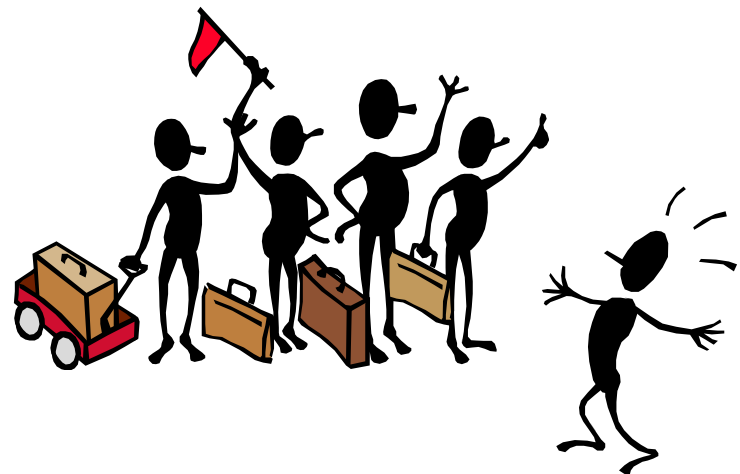

What To Bring (everyone): Sheets, blankets, pillows, towels, toiletries, bug spray, sun block, snacks, soft drinks, white t-shirt for tie-dye, musical instruments, ghost stories.

Facilities: New barrack style cabins with single beds, limited tent camping areas, recreation building, dining facility, hot showers, and flush toilets.
